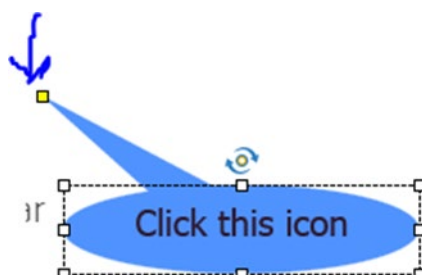
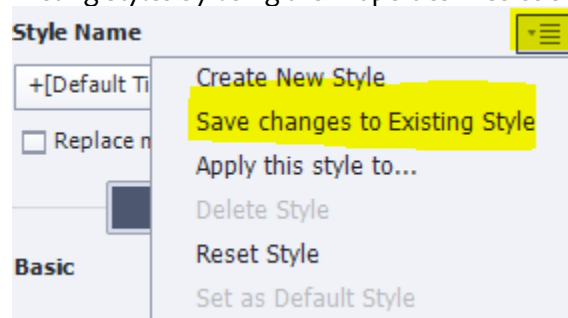


SOFTWARE SIMULATION – TIPS & TRICKS

- 1.) Projects can be rescaled for higher resolution monitors to perform 4k recordings by going on to **Modify** → **Rescale Project** before starting the recording.
- 2.) To take a manual screenshot press the **Print Screen** button on your keyboard
- 3.) Smart shapes can be edited or resized using the small yellow icon:



- 4.) All simulations are Pan-Able on Mobile Devices
- 5.) Recorded simulations can be printed as Handouts by clicking on **File** → **Print** → **Handouts** → **Publish** for distributing it for in-person classes.
- 6.) Global preferences - Open Preferences [**Edit** -> **Preference**] while no Document is open and the changes are retained for every new project that you create
 - a. If Simulation is recorded from the New Project option rather than within a project the Author can create multiple Simulation Modes at the same time.
- 7.) **Ctrl + Shift + Z** can be used to Mark errors that can be rectified later
- 8.) Making Changes can be saved to Existing Styles by using the Properties Area as shown below:



- 9.) Branching in one Project can be created using the "Aspire Branching" Project. If creating manually follow the steps as described below:
 - a. Create buttons on slide and name the slide as "branching"
 - b. Create Group of slides and give them an appropriate name (group1, group2 etc..)
 - c. Use the name of the group as the same name for the buttons to direct the right button to the right group.
- 10.) Use the Save as Responsive option to convert a Non-Responsive simulation Project to a Responsive simulation.
